The Slush Station was a lifesaver, offering an assortment of icy beverages that delighted the taste buds and provided a refreshing break from all the excitement.

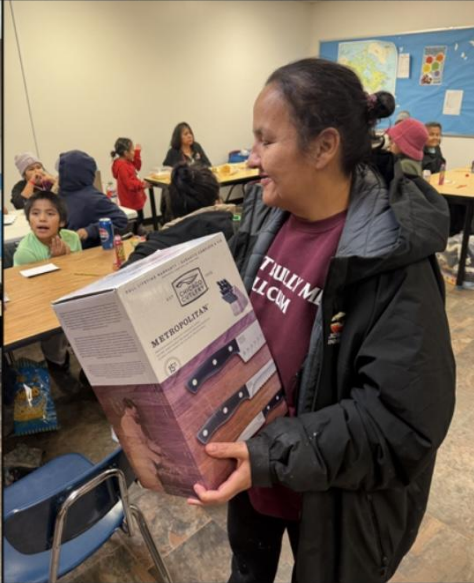
