We are also proud to share that **Ceejay Harper** and **Sidney Harper** will be representing our community at the Canada-Wide Science Fair in May 2026.

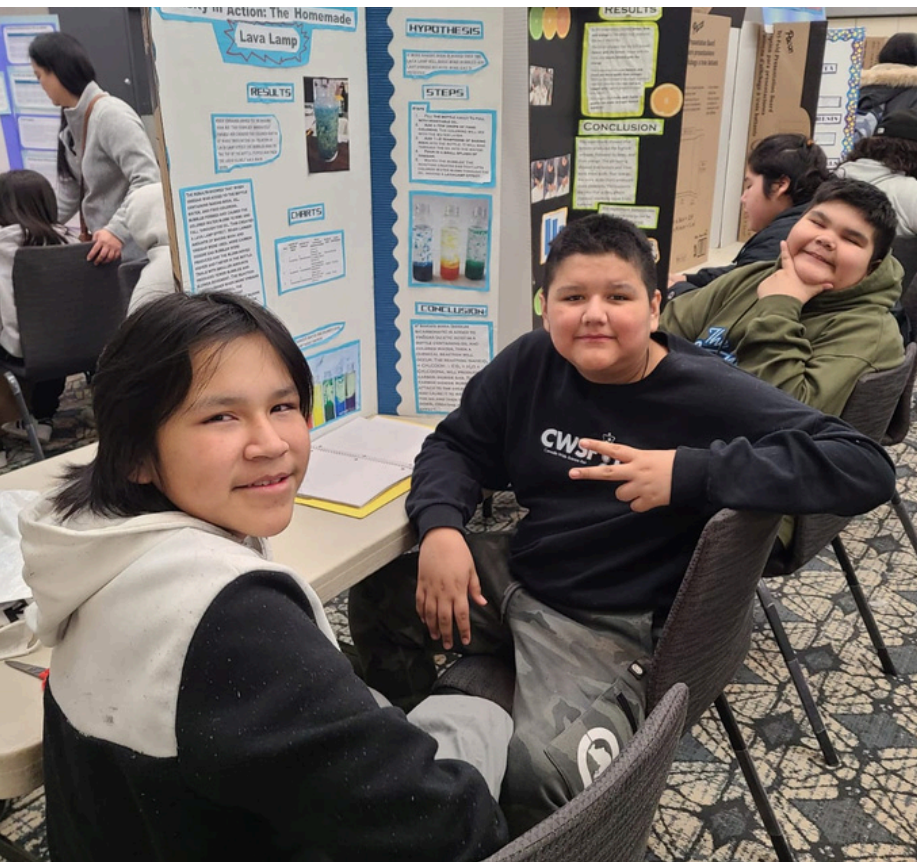
